Draft Leicestershire Together engagement framework

Why have we produced this framework?

Identifying and responding to users/local people's needs is a key priority for the Leicestershire Together partnership. In order to access the views of residents effectively and efficiently, we have developed this framework, which sets out channels of engagement with some of the key communities in Leicestershire.

We hope that this document will act as a directory for service providers from all sectors, making it easier for everyone to access, understand and respond to the needs of Leicestershire communities. We also need to remember to feed back to these communities how their input has influenced what we do, for example how key policies have changed, how service delivery has been tweaked to make it more responsive etc. It is important to note that there are likely to be some people who will not be reached through these routes.

Who is it aimed at - who are the target communities?

The Leicestershire Together partners have identified the following target groups, which are split into "communities of interest" and "communities of geography":

There are a number of other communities of interest who we work with on an on-going basis, including parents and people living in poverty. We also work with specific individuals/groups of service users, including victims of crime, bus users and patients.

We have various tools to reach the general public, including Leicestershire Matters, our Citizens Panel and Focus Groups, that we use to gather feedback on our services.

What is included in the Framework?

This document does not talk about tools (information about these can be found in other places, for example http://website/index/your_council/haveyoursay/consultation_methodology.htm).

Instead it outlines the key mechanisms for engagement with these communities - the routes through which people can contact representatives of these communities. This could be directly through a representative network of users, indirectly via a statutory or voluntary partnership or through the agencies that work with them on an on-going basis.

The Communities of Interest section includes the main Community of Interest Network - this is the key group or groups in Leicestershire made up of users/the target group. We have also identified the lead strategic partnership and the main agencies working with this community of interest. It is important to also recognise that not everyone within a particular community of interest is linked into these channels; indeed some people may view the representative networks/organisations as "gatekeepers" who do not represent and channel resources to all members of the community equally. You might need to think about other ways to engage with these people!

The Communities of Geography section identifies key contacts for the individual geographical levels. These contacts will be a route into other arrangements such as Town Centre Partnerships, Neighbourhood Forums etc. Details of the Community Forums that

are being established across the County will be added in once they are finalised, along with the contact details for the new Community Engagement Team at Leicestershire County Council who will be in post from September onwards and who can facilitate engagement at community forum, market town and priority neighbourhood level.

LAA PRIORITY NEIGHBOURHOODS

Leicestershire has 19 priority neighbourhood areas which were identified in consultation with the 7 District Local Strategic Partnerships. Data and information from the Index of Multiple Deprivation, Poverty and Social Exclusion Index and District Local Strategic Partnerships identified pockets of pronounced deprivation within the county, based around Output Areas.

District LSPs are leading the implementation of neighbourhood management in the 19 priority areas. Their aim is that each priority area will have a Neighbourhood Action Team (NAT) made up of front line workers from a range of agencies, supported by a neighbourhood manager. Neighbourhood Forums will be set up to act as sounding boards for the NATs - the forums will be made up of elected members and other county representatives.
